ELECTION PARKING ORDINANCE

Pursuant to the authority vested by RSA 41:11, RSA 41:11-a and RSA 47:17, the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Enfield enacts the following ordinance regulating the use of Whitney Hall Public Parking lot, Enfield Police Department Parking lot adjacent to Whitney Hall, and Enfield Community Building Parking Lot for election days as defined below.

Between the hours of 8:00 AM and 7:00 PM, no person or operator of a motor vehicle, truck, or tractor-trailer unit shall cause the same to be parked in the following location(s) for more than one (1) hour per the listed election days. The Moderator shall have the power to grant exemptions to this ordinance at his or her discretion. In the event that the Moderator is unavailable, the Assistant Moderator shall have such authority.

- Whitney Hall Municipal Parking Lot
- Enfield Police Station Parking Lot
- Enfield Community Building Parking Lot

This ordinance shall be in effect only for the following Election days, providing that due notice of an election is posted and is held at Whitney Hall, 23, Main Street, Enfield, New Hampshire or at the Enfield Community Building, 308 NH Route 4, Enfield, New Hampshire. It should be noted that whichever venue is the posted voting site, the restricted parking is only applicable to the parking lot assigned to said voting site.

- New Hampshire Primary Day
- Town Meeting Election of Town Officers (usually second Tuesday of March)
- September State Primary Day
- November General Election (First Tuesday in November)

Any motor vehicle or other device as defined in RSA 259 that is parked in violation of this Election Day Parking Ordinance may be cited for violation by a police officer. The penalty for violation of this ordinance shall be \$25.00 for each offense.

The following exception will apply: Individuals covered under the Americans with Disabilities Act.
