ARTICLES

Article 5: Operating Budget
Shall the Mascoma Valley Regional School District raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first deliberative session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling Twenty-Eight Million, Nine Hundred Twenty-Eight Thousand, Five Hundred Seventy-Five (\$28,928,575) Dollars? Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be Twenty-Eight Million, Six Hundred Nine Thousand, Eight Hundred Eighty-Eight (\$28,609,888) Dollars, which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Mascoma Valley Regional School District or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only.

Article 6: Teacher Negotiated Agreement

Shall the Mascoma Valley Regional School District vote to approve the cost items included in the collective bargaining agreement reached between the Mascoma Valley Regional School Board and the Mascoma Valley Regional Education Association which calls for the following increases in salaries and benefits at the current staffing level:

Fiscal Year	Estimated Increase
2021	\$315,462
2022	\$317,648
2023	\$343,966

And further to raise and appropriate Three Hundred Fifteen Thousand, Four Hundred Sixty-Two (\$315,462) Dollars for the current fiscal year, such sum representing the additional costs attributable to the increase in salaries and benefits required by the new agreement over those that would be paid at current staffing levels.
