

An Ordinance:

Section I. No person shall drink or consume at any time intoxicating liquor (as defined by New Hampshire Revised Statutes Annotated 21:33) nor carry or have in his/her possession any open container(s) of intoxicating liquor upon any public sidewalk, public street or way, public waters, public parking lots, public beach areas, public park and/or public playground within the Town of Enfield.

Section II. Any person violating the foregoing ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine not exceeding \$100.00 for each offense.


Section III. This ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon passage.

Section IV. This ordinance supercedes any outstanding ordinances relating to public consumption or display of intoxicating liquor (if any) within the Town of Enfield.
