Approval of Minutes-

- A. Minutes were reviewed for the October 4th meeting. Jay made a motion to accept.
 - Shirley and Sue asked for a correction as being excused from the meeting.
 - Alan made a motion to accept the minutes as corrected. Jerold seconded and the vote was accepted.

Business-

1) A proposal for replacing a retaining wall at a Crystal Lake residence was made by Scott Williams, from Pathway Consultants for Vince Memoli. This project located at 35 Algonquin Road would be a replacement of an existing failing concrete retaining wall. They are looking for the Commission's approval to expedite the review of a NHDES Wetlands Permit by Notification. The project also requires a NHDES Shoreland Permit by Notification. The project includes temporary sediment and erosion controls during the work. They would like the work to be done during the lake draw down period between November and December. The retaining wall would be made with the Redi-Rock product. The plan was presented by Scott. Consequences of not replacing the wall would be risks of further erosion and damage to the lawn and home of Mr. Memoli.

Shirley made a motion to approve the project and Sue seconded it. The vote was unanimous.

2) A proposal for repairing a retaining wall at another Crystal Lake residence was made by Glen and Shirley Green. The project requires a Shoreland Permit by Notification. They plan would be to use concrete in a replica stone wall form, similar to the recent retaining wall constructed at the Malz residence on Mascoma Lake.

Sue made a motion to approve and Jay seconded it. Shirley recused herself. The vote was unanimous.

3) Jerold and Allen reported the work they did at the Mascoma River Viewing station in back of the Town Office Building. Buckthorn and Multi-flora Rose was removed and the stumps were bagged to prevent re-sprouting. Jerold grass seeded the area also. The area will be re-evaluated in the spring and expanded if needed. A bench could be considered at a future time if it seemed appropriate.

Old Business-

1) Jay reported on things that need to be done on the Wildlife Action Plan. We can display one of our maps on a board in the town offices and put up some literature holders for handouts. Jay will take care of that. Dolores talked about a display of animals. How to utilize the web site

better needs to be discussed. Determining how to collect data, or whether to have pictures posted as well as deciding other locations to show the maps.

- 2) Jerold reported on the data he collected from the Harris Brook Survey. There were 50 documented visits. Most were women with children. One survey was of a suspicious nature, and Jerold reported that to the police.
- 3) Next meeting we need to focus on the Town Flower project. Bring in nominations of your choice.

Sue made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:07 PM. Alan seconded it and the vote was unanimous.
