## **Net Meeting support letter**

## **Community Power**

Rob Taylor inquired about Community Power (Town Manager asked Rob to look into that). Suggestion is for Rob to join the sub-committee on Community Power, currently made up by Jo-Ellen, Kim Quirk, Marta Ceroni and Charles Clark.

#### **Benchmarks**

Charles's work to change the light bulbs has been delayed by the closure of Town Hall and Community Building; he is waiting to hear from the Town about when that work can take place.

Charles has usage data for DPW info for the last eight years but needs monthly usage data for a number of town accounts.

### **Other**

Jo-Ellen attended the latest Municipal Facilities Advisory Committee; a participant advocated for the renovation of Whitney Hall and new safety building to be net zero (fossil fuel neutral) facilities.

At their next meeting on July 13 6:30, there will be discussion and decision about going to a fossil fuel neutral plan – members of the Enfield Energy Committee plan to attend.
