## **Minutes**

### **Meeting called to order 6:00 PM**

**Attendance:** Jo-Ellen Courtney, Marta Ceroni, Kim Quirk, Tracy Young Community members: eight in person and twelve on-line

**Minutes from February 28 meeting** Approved with minor corrections

**Enfield Community Power presentation plus Q & A** Kim Quirk presented overview of community power in Enfield, initiated by October 2019 Selectboard approval to establish a subcommittee to develop an energy aggregation plan and the Community Power plan development to its imminent launch in April.

Community members will be receiving a letter from the Community Power Coalition of NH within the next few days informing them they are automatically enrolled in Granite Basic rate of 15.8 cents/kWh. Granite Basic has 23.4% renewable content. Additional options are available to choose more renewables with an increase in cost including Clean 100 for 19.1 cents /kWh. All options are below the current rates of Liberty and Eversource who service Enfield.

**The Community Power information session and Q&A concluded at 6:50 pm. Members of the community in the room and online departed at that time.**

**Op Ed** An Op Ed is in development about Community Power in collaboration with the adjoining community power communities Lebanon, Hanover and Plainfield. Jo-Ellen asked for agreement for Enfield to be included in the listing of submitters.

Kim suggested the person writing it submit it under their own name rather than listing communities.

**Discussion Chair Rotation** Marta has agreed to take on the Chair in May.

**New Members** Discussion about possible new members and quorum requirements. Tracy Young, member of the Enfield Selectboard, is considered an official member of this committee. His presence can be counted to reach a quorum.

Conversation about posting agenda and minutes ensued.
