Community Power Coalition of NH: Kim and Jo Ellen attended the CPCNH meeting and will be writing something for the Enfield Newsletter. They will be addressing some of the anticipated questions of community power such as. 1. What will it cost?; 2. What if I have solar?; 3. How will it be distribute?; 4. Kim will write a plan for Enfield using information taken for the plans of other towns. She should have something put together by October. Kim will also incorporate ideas from the CPCNH plan.

The students at Hanover High will be presenting a program on reducing the greenhouses gas emission for their school by 77% by 2050. This program will be presented on 7 October at 11:00 am.
