

Heritage Commission March 28, 2019 Minutes

The Enfield Heritage Commission met on March 28, 2019 at 4:30 PM in the Whitney Hall Conference Room. Those in attendance: Marjorie Carr, Suzanne Hinman, Linda Jones, Shirley Green, Mary Ann Haagen, Celie Aufiero, Phil Walz, Ryan Aylesworth, and Meredith Smith, Chair. Also attending was architect and structural engineer Robin Adair Logan. The February minutes were approved as written.

Robin Logan: Meredith introduced Ms. Logan to the Commission and after brief introductions from Commission members; Ms. Logan described her past work on historic buildings and especially her involvement with the Hartford Municipal Building. She also remarked on her tour of Enfield buildings, noting that both the Town House and Whitney Hall were very special buildings and should be preserved. She emphasized that there was no need to tear down any buildings and that she had never torn down a building in her 30-year career.

Mascoma Lakeside Park Update: Meredith gave an update on the Lakeside Park project and the necessity of having the Phase Two archeological study done. This will require three competitive bids from archeology survey companies. An RFP will go out very soon to get bids for this work.

Certified Local Government: Due to time constraints, the discussion of Certified Local Government was postponed until the next month's meeting. Linda Jones presented Commission members with a hand-out of what she had learned about Bristol's CLG program and their regulations. Members will study these regulations prior to the next meeting.

Enfield Shaker Village Scenic Byway: Meredith showed the Commission a copy of a possible poster for the Scenic Byway. She will ask Alisa to have several printed up to distribute around Town.

Appointment of Linda Jones: Meredith announced that Linda Jones would be proposed to the Selectboard for appointment to an up-coming vacancy on the Planning Board.

The meeting was adjourned at 6 PM.
