VOLUNTEERS SOUGHT FOR MUNICIPAL FACILITIES ADVISORY COMMITTEE

A Municipal Facilities Advisory Committee is being established as an ad hoc group to review, evaluate and make recommendations regarding town-owned buildings for the purpose of informing proposed future capital improvements/investments.

The Committee will serve for a period of approximately one year (April 2019 – March 2020). The Committee may be convened beyond March 2020 as appropriate.

The Town is looking for three Enfield residents to serve on this committee alongside six local officials. Please send a letter of interest, identifying why you feel you would be a strong fit for the committee, to Ryan Aylesworth, Town Manager at raylesworth@enfield.nh.us or hand deliver to the Town Manager's Office.

The Committee will consist of nine members. Every effort will be made to appoint at least two members with



professional building design/construction expertise. Members will be chosen from a pool of individuals from the following groups:

- Selectboard Member (ex officio member)
- Town Manager (ex officio member)
- Library Trustee (1) [See note below]
- Budget Committee Member (1)
- Capital Improvement Program (CIP) Committee Member (1)
- Heritage Commission Member (1)
- At-large Enfield Residents (3)

A Library Trustee representative is needed due to State statute RSA 202-A, which gives the Library Trustees jurisdiction over library buildings and facilities. The Board of Selectmen have jurisdiction over all other Town buildings and facilities.

Throughout the process, municipal department heads will be invited to attend Committee meetings to share valuable input regarding their respective facility needs and preferences.
