Fund Raiser: Lori Bliss has volunteered to do a pizza night where 15% of the sales will go to the Old Home Days fund and EHOP will match that. A date will be decided on in the next month. Patty and Stephanie will take care of publicizing this.

Other Events: Band concert confirmed; Meredith will check with Julie about the Methodist Church supper and quilt show; Ice Cream Social is on; Marjorie will check with the Historical Society regarding the Lockhaven Schoolhouse; Kristin has been in communication with Whaleback; Kristin will also check with Alf Elvstead on possibly having a Pak Boat demonstration. Meredith will check with the Sailing Club as to whether they will be participating. The Lionesses have asked to do a breakfast which will be on Saturday. Shirley will contact the Lionesses to firm up the date for the breakfast.
