

Old Home Days Committee Agenda

Wednesday February 3, 2020 at 5:30PM, Zoom

Meeting was called to order at 5:35PM

The 2021 meeting schedule was discussed. With the availability of zoom, we may be able to adjust the day/time to allow people a little more schedule flexibility. Kristin will send out a doodle poll.

Shirley Green and Stephanie Hill are both up for renewal in 2021; both have decided to renew for another term. Kristin will let Alisa know.

The committee then discussed the 2021 celebrations. With vaccine rollout underway, we still feel that doing an entire 3 day celebration with both indoor and outdoor components would be too much. It was decided that a one day celebration (Saturday, July 24) would be best. The goal would be to have events at the three main locations- Shaker Museum, Lakeside Park, and Huse Park, throughout the day, as well as to encourage other groups to host their events (conservation commission hike, lockehaven schoolhouse, etc). This will allow people to spread out in town rather than congregate in one spot.

Kristin will reach out to the museum about their availability/thoughts.

Lori would be able to have EHOP offer pre-order lunch boxes at lakeside park for lunch. We would also hope to have musical entertainment there. We would like the cruise night to occur at Huse Park, also with live music.

The committee decided that there should be nothing involving outside vendors (such as a craft fair component). The celebration should be kept simple this year.

Additionally, we discussed not fundraising this year, but instead encouraging donations to Enfield-based non-profits. This will have to be voted on at a later date.
