Ms Labrie updated Mascoma Valley Parks and Recreation Activities:

Lifeguards and Camp Counselors are still needed for summer positions.

Huse Park Camp - filled for all 6 weeks with waiting lists

- 5 counselors currently on staff - looking for 1 - 2 more counselors to open up 10 more camper spots
- Yoga on Fridays at summer camp is in the works.

Theater Camp - Canceled due to extenuating circumstances.

Camper spots are still open at sports camps:

- Volleyball Camp - Ms. Labrie will be running this youth camp
- Basketball - A Paul Hogan Camp
- Soccer - Challenger Soccer Camp

Farmer's Market - opened last Saturday (5/14/22) with good vendor participation and well Attended. New Banner for Enfield Farmer's Market has been ordered.

Bone Builders - senior strengthening program emphasizing fall-prevention, meeting this week for memorandum of understanding. Anticipated offering of two times per week.

Possible Friday evening Adult Yoga class also in the planning stages.
