At this time, The Enfield Police Department is compelled to make some temporary changes due to COVID-19. Unfortunately, we need to yield some of our duties and functions to hold caution and take reasonable steps for the exposure to COVID-19 for those who work at the Enfield Police Department. All personnel of the Enfield Police Department remain ready to respond to the needs of the community. This includes staffing and operations for emergencies, and calls of priority. Effectively immediately, the Enfield Police Department is suspending some of our lower level services. These suspended services include:

VIN verifications
Ride-a-longs
Some Public Programs

This includes Coffee With A Cop, which is postponed for March 18th
Station tours
Fingerprinting

The front administration lobby will be open by appointment only. This means you will need to telephone 603-632-7501 for all of your administrative needs, questions, non emergency reporting, and make appointments. When you call you may be asked a few questions by the department member answering your call. This is to better appoint your needs in the right direction promptly.

The Officer's of the department will be using protective equipment as needed and carrying out social distancing as necessary.
